We want to ensure the competition, as far as possible for everyone attending, is a safe and healthy environment that will be enjoyable and successful.

All competition in Scotland will be operated in line with Scottish Government and Public health Scotland and Scottish Swimming Guidance, current at the time of the competition taking place. Full details will be issued nearer the date of the competition.

All competitors and other attendees are required to adhere to the conditions of the competition to ensure that we stay compliant and safe. Anyone failing to follow the conditions will be refused access or removed from the venue and no refund will be offered.

At present Scotland is at below Level 0. However these levels of restrictions may have changed by the competition dates. SASA Midland District will be guided by and will implement all relevant requirements by Scottish Swimming, Sport Scotland and the Scottish Government at that time.

Competition Disclaimer

In the event of cancellation or abandonment of the event, refunds, if any, will be made at the absolute discretion of SASA Midland District. SASA Midland District will have no legal liability to make a refund or to pay any form of consequential or indirect damage such as loss of enjoyment, travel, catering and accommodation.

Eligibility

All competitors must be a registered member of a club affiliated to SASA Midland District and a registered member of the Scottish Amateur Swimming Association having paid their current registration fee.

A Swimmer can only compete for one Club/Team during the meet and must be eligible to swim for their Club/Team in accordance with Company Rule 5.1

LEAGUE RULES

- Each team can be a maximum of 36 swimmers as follows
 - 16 Female, 16 Male & 4 relay only swimmers
- Swimmers are interchangeable with the exception they can only swim in one league per season.,
- Swimmers can only swim for one team within a club across the three rounds
- There are no restrictions on which swimmers a club enters
- A swimmer can swim up to 2 events plus relays at each meet.
- Each Team must appoint a Captain & Vice Captain
- Each Club must appoint a Team Manager
- Swimmers must only swim in their own age group and one swimmer must be entered in a maximum of two events at each meet excluding relays
- Over the top starts will be used.
- All events will be HDW.
- All swimmers must have paid their current SASA & Midlands District registration fee.
- Points will be awarded as follows
 - Individual Events
 - 1st – 6pts
 - 2nd – 5pts
 - 3rd – 4pts
 - 4th – 3pts
 - 5th – 2 pts
 - Relay Events
 - 1st – 12pts
 - 2nd – 10pts
 - 3rd – 8pts
 - 4th – 6pts
 - 5th – 4 pts
- The team with the Most points after round 3 will be Promoted to League One for the next year.

Swimwear

British Swimming and Scottish Swimming advise that FINA BL 8.1 only applies to Olympic Games and FINA events. A suit check will only be made if a World or European record is being claimed. There is not a requirement for officials to check that costumes are on the approved FINA list. Bylaws BL 8.2 and BL 8.3 cover our requirements for design and material.

SW8.0 Scottish Swimming Rules

SW8.8 Swimwear Policy

SW 8.8.1 For events held under the direct jurisdiction and control of Scottish Swimming the Scottish Swimming "Swimwear Policy" shall also apply. This policy is included in full in Appendix 1 of these regulations.

At this meet the policy on Agreed Swimwear & the policy on Technical Swim Suits shall apply

Media & Photography Information

Team Staff

All poolside staff must apply for a pass.

Rounds 1 – 3 – Free of Charge

Teams will be limited to 3 members of staff on poolside

Application Deadline: Friday 15th September 2023, Friday 26th January 2024, TBC

A pass is required for any team staff wishing to be on poolside and entitles you to entry to the meet, poolside access, without a valid pass the member of staff will NOT be permitted entry to the event.

All passes must be printed and worn by all team personnel and made visible at all times.

Applying for a Pass

- All applications have to be submitted [online](#).
- **Please Note: All chaperone/team manager passes must be confirmed by the Head Club/Team coach as detailed on the online application form**
- All applicants MUST be Disclosure Scotland/PVG/CRB checked through either: Scottish Swimming/Swim England/Swim Wales. It is the responsibility of the Club/Coach to ensure that, if they require their swimmers to have coach/chaperone representation on the poolside, their application is made in good time and that the relevant PVG/Criminal Records Bureau(CRB)/Disclosure & Barring Service(DBS) forms have been completed and sent to the Scottish Swimming/Swim England/Swim Wales office(s)
- SASA Midland District will not issue any Coach/Chaperone Pass unless a person has a valid Disclosure Certificate/PVG/CRB through the Scottish Swimming/Swim England/Swim Wales. In-line with current legislation, valid Disclosure Certificates/PVG/CRB from any other agency, will not be accepted.
